San Timoteo Energy Associates conducted a study to compare electric service options for UCSF's new 955,000 sf Full Services Patient Care Facility. Bringing in new electric service from local utility service provider PG&E was compared with connecting to the campus' central cogeneration utility plant for electrical and other services. Analysis included cost, technical feasibility, reliability, and carbon footprint for each option.

San Timoteo was an active participant in UCSF Health's "choosing by design" process, where input on all analysis parameters was taken into consideration to make the final decision on utility supply for this project.
